

Mitsinjoarivo Wall, Dancing With The World

Madagascar Tsaranoro Valley

In the fall of 2013, South African climbers Benj de Charmoy, Duncan Fraser, and Leo Le Roux established the nine-pitch route Dancing with the World (300m, 6c). The line climbs left of some prominent black streaks on the left side of the Mitsinjoarivo Wall, reaching the left-most summit. They established the route capsule-style over seven days, bolting ground-up, then climbed the route free in a day from the base.
